The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 16, 2023, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed gabapentin, a controlled substance classified as a Schedule V non-narcotic, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 16, 2023, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant appeared in a public place manifestly under the influence of a controlled substance, or other intoxicating substance, excluding alcohol, not therapeutically administered, to the degree that he may have endangered himself or other persons or property, or unreasonably annoyed persons in his vicinity, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky charges that on or about September 18, 2023, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant attempted to commit the offense of Disarming a Peace Officer when he intentionally attempting to remove a firearm or other deadly weapon from the person of Adair County Deputy Chris Tweedy, a peace officer, when the peace officer was acting within the scope of his official duties; or when he intentionally attempted to deprive Adair County Deputy Chris Tweedy, a peace officer, of the officer's use of his firearm or other deadly weapon, when the peace officer was acting within the scope of his official duties, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 18, 2023, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully entered or remained in or upon the premises of the Adair County Sheriff's Office, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 18, 2023, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Assault in the Third Degree upon Adair County Deputy Chris Tweedy, who is a state, county, city, or federal peace officer, by intentionally causing or attempting to cause physical injury to Adair County Deputy Chris Tweedy, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 18, 2023, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Assault in the Third Degree upon Adair County Sheriff Josh Brockman, who is a state, county, city, or federal peace officer, by intentionally causing or attempting to cause physical injury to Adair County Sheriff Josh Brockman, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 18, 2023, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Assault in the Third Degree upon Columbia Police Officer Trevor Foster, who is a state, county, city, or federal peace officer, by intentionally causing or attempting to cause physical injury to Columbia Police Officer Trevor Foster, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 18, 2023, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree when, under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, he wantonly engaged in conduct which created a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to Adair County Deputy Chris Tweedy, when the Defendant struck Adair County Deputy Chris Tweedy in the chin, struck him in the chest with his elbow, and attempted to stab him with a pair of scissors, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 18, 2023, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe that he had such right, he intentionally or wantonly defaced, destroyed, or damaged a magazine rack, and also the taser and duty belt of Adair County Deputy Chris Tweedy, owned by the Adair County Sheriff's Office, and/or another entity/person, causing pecuniary loss of more than \$1,000, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 18, 2023, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevented or attempted to prevent Adair County Deputy Chris Tweedy, and/or Adair County Sheriff Josh Brockman, and/or Columbia Police Officer Trevor Foster, who were recognized to be acting under color of official authority, from effecting an arrest of the defendant by using or threatening to use physical force or violence against Adair County Deputy Chris Tweedy, and/or Adair County Sheriff Josh Brockman, and/or Columbia Police Officer Trevor Foster, or by using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to Adair County Deputy Chris Tweedy, and/or Adair County Sheriff Josh Brockman, and/or Columbia Police Officer Trevor Foster, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
