

The Grand Jury charges that on or about Aug. 21, 2020 through through, in Green County, Kentucky the above-named defendant subjects another person to sexual contact by forcible compulsion or he subjects another person to sexual contact who is incapable of consent because he or she is physically helpless; is less than twelve (12) years old or is mentally incapacitated or being twentyone (21 years old or more, he subjects another person who is less that sixteen (16) years old to sexual contact; engages in masturbation in the presence of another person who is less than sixteen (16) years old and knows or has reason to know the other person is present; or engages in masturbation while using the Internet, telephone, or other electronic communication device while communicating with a minor who the person knows is less that sixteen (16) years old, and the minor can see or hear the person masturbate; or being a person in a position of authority or position of special trust, as defined in KRS 532.045, he regardless of his or her age, subjects a minor who is less than eighteen (18) years old, with whom he or she comes into contact as a result of the position, to sexual contact or engages in masturbation in the presence of the minor and knows or has reason to know the minor is present or engages in masturbation while using the internet, telephone, or other electronic communication device while communicating with a minor who the person knows is less than sixteen (16) years old, and the minor can see or hear the person masturbate or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNTS 4-6

The Grand Jury charges that on or about Aug. 21, 2020 through Aug. 28, 2020 in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant engages in sexual intercourse with another person who is incapable of consent because he or she is an individual with an intellectual disability; being 21 years old or more he or she engages in sexual intercourse with another person less than sixteen (16) years old; being twenty-one (21) years old or more, he or she engages in sexual intercourse with another person less than eighteen (18) years old and for whom he or she provides a foster family home as defined in KRS 600.020; being a person in a position of authority or position of special trust, as defined in KRS 532.045, he or she engages in sexual intercourse with a minor under eighteen (18) years old with whom he or she comes into contact as a result of that position; being a jailer or an employee, contractor, vendor, or volunteer of the Department of Corrections Department of Juvenile Justice, or a detention facility for the custody, supervision, evaluation, or treatment of offenders, he or she subjects a person who he or she knows is incarcerated, supervised, evaluated, or treated by the Department of Corrections, Department of Juvenile Justice, detention facility, or contracting entity, to sexual intercourse or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNTS 7-10

The Grand Jury charges that on or about Aug. 21, 2020 Aug. 28, 2020 , in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant through subjects another person to sexual contact by forcible compulsion or he subjects another person to sexual contact who is incapable of consent because he or she is physically helpless; is less than twelve (12) years old or is mentally incapacitated or being twentyone (21) years old or more, he subjects another person who is less than sixteen (16) years old to sexual contact; engages in masturbation in the presence of another person who is less than sixteen (16) years old and knows or has reason to know the other person is present; engages in masturbation while using the internet, telephone, or other electronic communication device while communicating with a minor who the person knows is less than sixteen (16) years old, and the minor can see or hear the person masturbate; or being a person in a position of authority or position of special trust, as defined in KRS 532.045, he regardless of his or her age, subjects a minor who is less than eighteen (18) years old, with whom he or she comes into contact as a result of the position, to sexual contact or engages in masturbation in the presence of the minor and knows or has reason to know the minor is present or engages in masturbation while using the internet, telephone, or other electronic communication device while communicating with a minor who the person knows is less than sixteen (16) years old, and the minor can see or hear the person masturbate or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



The Grand Jury charges that on or about February 10, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, he wantonly engages in conduct which creates a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person or aided abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about February 10, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, he wantonly engages in conduct which creates a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person or aided abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about February 10, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant while operating a motor vehicle with intent to elude or flee, the person knowingly or wantonly disobeys a direction to stop his or her motor vehicle, given by a person recognized to be a police officer and at least (1) of the following conditions exists: the person is fleeing immediately after committing and act of domestic violence as defined in KRS 403.720 the person is driving under the influence of alcohol or any other substance or combination of substance in violation of KRS 189A.010; the person is driving while his or her driver's license is suspended for violating KRS 189A.010; or be fleeing or eluding, the person is the cause, or creates substantial risk, of serious physical injury or death of any person or property; or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about February 10, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant shall pass to the left of them and shall not again drive to the right until reasonably clear of those vehicles or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about February 10, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a vehicle upon a highway at a greater speed than is reasonable and prudent, having no regard for the traffic and for the condition and use of the highway or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about February 10, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operator of any vehicle upon a highway shall operate the vehicle in a careful manner, with regard for the safety and convenience of pedestrians and other vehicles upon the highway. No person shall willfully operate nay vehicle on any highway in such a manner as to injure the highway aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about May 17, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky the above-named defendant having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe that he has such right, he intentionally or wantonly defaces, destroys or damages any property causing pecuniary loss of \$1000 or more or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about May 17, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a

sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21)or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
