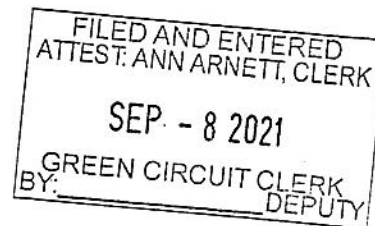

COUNTS 1-3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 27, 2021 through April 28, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant recklessly, with a deadly weapon or

dangerous instrument, or intentionally causes or attempts to cause physical injury to: a state, county, city, or federal peace officer or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 27, 2021 through April 28, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky the above-named defendant as a pedestrian and with intent to elude or flee, the person knowingly or wantonly disobeys an order to stop, given by a person recognized to be a peace officer, and at least one (1) of the following conditions exists: the person is fleeing immediately after committing an act of domestic violence as defined in KRS 403.720; or by fleeing or eluding, the person is the cause of, or creates a substantial risk of, serious physical injury or death to any person or property or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 27, 2021 through April 28, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevents or attempts to prevent a peace officer, recognized to be acting under color of his official authority from effecting an arrest of the actor or another by: using or threatening to use physical force or violence against the peace officer or another; or using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to the peace officer or another or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNTS 6-8:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 27, 2021 through April 28, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant wantonly engages in conduct which creates a substantial danger of physical injury to another person or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 9:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 27, 2021 through April 28, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally placed another person in reasonable apprehension of imminent physical injury or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 10:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 27, 2021 through April 28, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant when he or she: in a public place and with intent to cause public inconvenience, annoyance, or alarm, or wantonly creating a risk thereof: engages in fighting or in violent, tumultuous, or threatening behavior; make unreasonable noise; or refuses to obey an official order to disperse issued to maintain public safety in dangerous proximity to a fire, hazard, or other emergency; or creates a hazardous or physically offensive condition by any act that serves no legitimate purpose or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of

Kentucky.

COUNT 11:


The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 27, 2021 through April 28, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

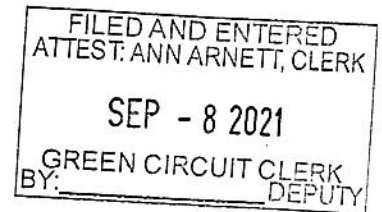

Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:


The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 27, 2021 through April 28, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant is over the age of 21 and stood convicted of at least two felonies after his 18th birthday **OR** one (1) or more felony sex crimes against a minor as defined in KRS 17.500, and now stands convicted of any one (1) or more felonies. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about September 1, 2020 through March 1, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant uses for the purpose of obtaining money, goods, services, or anything else of value a credit or debit card obtained or retained in violation of KRS 434.570 to 434.650, or any of such sections, or a credit or debit card which he knows is

forged expired, or revoked; or obtain money, goods, services, or anything else of value by representing without consent of the cardholder that he is the holder of a specified card or by representing that he is the holder of a card and such card has not in fact been issued; uses a credit or debit card obtained or retained in violation of KRS 434.570 to 434.650, or any of such sections, or a credit or debit card which he knows is forged, expired, or revoked, as authority or identification to cash or attempts to cash or otherwise negotiate or transfer a check or other order for payment of money, whether or not negotiable, if said negotiation or transfer or attempt to negotiate or transfer would constitute a crime under KRS 514.040 or 516.030; or deposits into his account or any account via an automated banking device, a false, fictitious, forged, altered or counterfeit check, draft, money order, or any other such document not his lawful or legal property or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:


The Grand Jury charges: That on or about September 1, 2020 through March 1, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly possessed or used any current or former identifying information of another person or family member or ancestor of the other person such as that person's or family member's or ancestor's name, address, telephone number, electronic mail address, Social Security number, driver's license number, birth date, personal identification number or code, and any other information which could be used to identify the person, including unique biometric data, with the intent to represent that he or she is the other person for the purpose of: depriving that other person of property; obtaining benefits or property to which he or she would otherwise not be entitled; making financial or credit transactions using the other person's identity; avoiding detection; or commercial or political benefit or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about September 1, 2020 through March 1, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant unlawfully took or exercised control over movable property (valued over \$500.00) of another with intent to deprive him thereof; or obtains immovable property of another or any interest therein with intent to benefit himself or another not entitled thereto or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act.
