**COUNT 1:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 19, 2020 through May 7, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant subjected (KC), engaged in sexual intercourse with another person by forcible compulsion; or He engages in sexual intercourse with another person who is incapable of consent because he: is physically helpless; or is less than twelve (12) years old or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 2:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 19, 2020 through May 7, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant engages in deviate sexual intercourse with another person (KC) by forcible compulsion; or engages in deviate sexual intercourse with another person who is incapable of consent because he/she: is physically helpless or is less than twelve (12) years old or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 3:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 19, 2020 through May 7, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant employs, consents to, authorizes or induces a minor to engage in a sexual performance or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 4:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about October 19, 2020 through May 7, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant uses or causes the use of any camera, videotape, photo optical, photoelectric, or other image recording device for the purpose of observing, viewing, photographing, filming or videotaping the sexual conduct, genitals, or nipple of the female breast of another person without that person's consent; and uses or divulges any image so obtained for consideration; or distributes any image so obtained by live or recorded visual medium, electronic mail, the internet or a commercial on-line service or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNTS 5-8:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about October 19, 2020 through May 7, 2022 in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant engages in sexual intercourse with another person who is incapable of consent because he or she is an individual with an intellectual disability; being 21 years old or more he or she engages in sexual intercourse with another person less than sixteen (16) years old; being twenty-one (21) years old or more, he or she engages in sexual intercourse with another person less than eighteen (18) years old and for whom he or she provides a foster family home as defined in KRS 600.020; being a person in a position of authority or position of special trust, as defined in KRS 532.045, he or she engages in sexual

intercourse with a minor under eighteen (18) years old with whom he or she comes into contact as a result of that position; being a jailer or an employee, contractor, vendor, or volunteer of the Department of Corrections Department of Juvenile Justice, or a detention facility for the custody, supervision, evaluation, or treatment of offenders, he or she subjects a person who he or she knows is incarcerated, supervised, evaluated, or treated by the Department of Corrections, Department of Juvenile Justice, detention facility, or contracting entity, to sexual intercourse or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNTS 9-11:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about October 19, 2020 through May 7, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant being twenty-one (21) years old or more, he or she engages in deviate sexual intercourse with another person less than sixteen (16) years old; Being at least ten (10) years older than a person who is sixteen (16) or seventeen (17) years old at the time of deviate sexual intercourse, he or she engages in deviate sexual intercourse with the person; Being twenty-one (21) years old or more, he or she engages in deviate sexual intercourse with another person less than eighteen (18) years old and for whom he or she provides a foster family home as defined in KRS 600.020; Being a person in a position of authority or position of special trust, as defined in KRS 532.045, he or she engages in deviate sexual intercourse with a minor less than eighteen (18) years old with whom he or she comes into contact as a result of that position; or Being a jailer, or an employee, contractor, vendor, or volunteer of the Department of Corrections, Department of Juvenile Justice, or a detention facility as defined in KRS 520.010, or of an entity under contract with either department or a detention facility for the custody, supervision, evaluation, or treatment of offenders, he or she subjects a person who he or she knows is incarcerated, supervised, evaluated, or treated by the Department of Corrections, Department of Juvenile Justice, detention facility, or contracting entity, to deviate sexual intercourse or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNTS 12-14:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about October 19, 2020 through May 7, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant subjects (KR), under the age of 12 in a continuous course of conduct, no less than two times, to sexual contact by forcible compulsion or he subjects another person to sexual contact who is incapable of consent because he or she is physically helpless; is less than twelve (12) years old or is mentally incapacitated or being twenty-one (21) years old or more, he subjects another person who is less than sixteen (16) years old to sexual contact; engages in masturbation in the presence of another person who is less than sixteen (16) years old and knows or has reason to know the other person is present; being a person in a position of authority or position of special trust, as defined in KRS 532.045, he regardless of his or her age, subjects a minor who is less than eighteen (18) years old, with whom he or she comes into contact as a result of the position, to sexual contact or engages in masturbation in the presence of the minor and knows or has reason to know the minor is present or engages in masturbation while using the internet, telephone, or other electronic communication device while communicating with a minor who the person knows is less than sixteen (16) years old, and the minor can see or hear the person masturbate or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the

Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNTS 15-22:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 19, 2020 through May 7, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant unlawful and knowingly used a communications system, including computers, computer networks, computer bulletin boards, cellular telephones or any other electronic means, for the purpose of: Procuring or promoting the use of a minor, including a peace officer, or a person working in coordination with law enforcement, posing as a minor if the person believes that the peace officer or the person working in coordination with law enforcement is a minor or is wanton or reckless in that belief; or Procuring or promoting the use of a minor from an adult intermediary, including a peace officer, or a person working in coordination with law enforcement, posing as an adult intermediary for a minor if the person believes that the peace officer or the person working in coordination with law enforcement is an adult intermediary for a minor or is wanton or reckless in that belief or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 23:**


The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 19, 2020 through May 7, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowing a person to be minor, or having possession of such facts that he should reasonably know that such person is a minor, and with knowledge of the content and character of the material, he knowingly: sends or causes to be sent; or exhibits; or distributes, or offers to distribute, obscene material to a minor or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 24:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 19, 2020 through May 7, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant having knowledge of its content and character, he or she: Sends or causes to be sent into this state for sale or distribution; or Brings or causes to be brought into this state for sale or distribution; or in this state, he or she: Exhibits for profit or gain; or Distributes; or Offers to distribute; or Offers to distribute; or has in his or her possession with intent to distribute, exhibit for profit or gain or offer to distribute, any matter portraying a sexual performance by a minor or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
