The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 23, 2022 through April 24, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally or wantonly causes physical injury to another person; or with reckless he causes physical injury to another person by means of a deadly weapon or a dangerous instrument or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 23, 2022 through April 24, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant when he or she: in a public place and with intent to cause public inconvenience, annoyance, or alarm, or wantonly creating a risk thereof; engages in fighting or in violent, tumultuous, or threatening behavior; make unreasonable noise; or refuses to obey an official order to disperse issued to maintain public safety in dangerous proximity to a fire, hazard, or other emergency; or creates a hazardous or physically offensive condition by any act that serves no legitimate purpose or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 23, 2022 through April 24, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky the above-named defendant appeared in a public place manifestly under the influence of alcohol to the degree that he may endanger himself or other persons or property, or unreasonably annoy persons in his vicinity; a person is guilty of drinking alcoholic beverages in a public place when he drinks an alcoholic beverage in public place, or in or upon any passenger coach, or other vehicle commonly used for the transportation of passengers, or in or about any depot, platform or waiting room or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 19, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant recklessly, with deadly weapon or dangerous instrument, or intentionally causes or attempts to cause physical injury to: a state, county, city, or federal peace officer: Intentionally causes a person, whom the actor knows or reasonably should know to be a peace officer discharging official duties, to come into contact with saliva, vomit, mucus, blood, seminal fluid, urine or feces without the consent of the peace officer or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 19, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevents or attempts to prevent a peace officer, recognized to be acting under color of his official authority from effecting an arrest of the actor or another by: using or threatening to use physical force or violence against the peace officer or another; or using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to the peace officer or another or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about July 19, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant appears in a public place manifestly under the influence of a controlled substance, or other intoxicating substance, excluding alcohol (unless the alcohol is present in combination with any of the above), not therapeutically administered, to the degree that he may endanger himself or other persons or property, or unreasonably annoy person in his vicinity or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 19, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe that he has such right, he intentionally or wantonly defaces, destroys or damages any property; or tampers with property so as knowingly to endanger the person or property of another or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act.


