The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about November 11, 2022, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Riot in the First Degree when the Defendant, acting either alone and/or in complicity with other persons, knowingly participated in a riot and in the course of and as a result of such riot a person other than one (1) of the participants suffered physical injury and/or substantial property damage occurred, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

# COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about November 11, 2022, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Assault in the Fourth Degree when the Defendant, acting either alone and/or in complicity with other persons, intentionally or wantonly caused physical injury to cor recklessly caused physical injury to by means of a deadly weapon or a dangerous instrument, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
