COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 17, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle on a highway in a manner that was without regard for the safety and convenience of pedestrians and other vehicles upon the highway, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 17, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as it was not equipped with a windshield that complied with the requirements of KRS 189.110, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 17, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he failed to maintain a validly issued insurance card inside his vehicle, as required by KRS Chapter 304, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 17, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he did not have his operator's license in his possession, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 17, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle on the public roadways at such time as the Defendant failed to wear a properly adjusted and fastened seat belt, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 17, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed methamphetamine, this being a second such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 17, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Second Degree when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed buprenorphine (a/k/a suboxone), a Schedule III narcotic, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 17, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed gabapentin, a controlled substance classified as a Schedule V non-narcotic, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 9:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 17, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed with the intent to use, drug paraphernalia for the purpose of planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packing, re-packing, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human body a controlled substance in violation of KRS 218A, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 10:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 17, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to give an appropriate signal before turning his motor vehicle, in violation of KRS 189.380, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 11:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 17, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to notify the Kentucky Department of Transportation that he had changed his address as required by law, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 26 – 27, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Unlawful Imprisonment in the First Degree, contrary to KRS 509.020, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of March 26 – 27, 2024, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of March 26 – 27, 2024, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of March 26 – 27, 2024, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 22, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree when, under circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life, he wantonly engaged in conduct which created a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person(s) by operating a motor vehicle at a high rate of speed and in an otherwise wanton manner during a police pursuit and thereby endangering the life of [REDACTED], a minor female whose date of birth is [REDACTED] who was a passenger in the Defendant's vehicle, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 22, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree when, under circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life, he wantonly engaged in conduct which created a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person(s) by operating a motor vehicle at a high rate of speed and in an otherwise wanton manner during a police pursuit and thereby endangering the life of [REDACTED], a minor male whose date of birth is unknown but who was approximately two (2) years old, who was a passenger in the Defendant's vehicle, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 22, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone and/or in complicity with another person(s), knowingly and unlawfully took or exercised control over numerous items of merchandise, including cell phone chargers and accessories, having a value of less than \$500, same being the moveable property of Walmart, with the intent to deprive the owner thereof, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
