COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 20, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Disorderly Conduct in the Second Degree when, in a public place and with the intent to cause public inconvenience, annoyance or alarm, or wantonly creating a risk thereof, she engaged in fighting or in violent, tumultuous, or threatening behavior, or she

made unreasonable noise, or she refused to obey an official order to disperse issued to maintain public safety in dangerous proximity to a fire, hazard or other emergency, or when she created a hazardous or physically offensive condition by an act that served no legitimate purpose, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 20, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevented or attempted to prevent Kentucky State Trooper Maverick Gadberry and/or Kentucky State Trooper Billy Begley, who were recognized to be acting under color of official authority, from effecting an arrest of the defendant by using or threatening to use physical force or violence against Kentucky State Trooper Maverick Gadberry and/or Kentucky State Trooper Billy Begley, or by using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to Kentucky State Trooper Maverick Gadberry and/or Kentucky State Trooper Billy Begley, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 20, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when she knowingly and unlawfully possessed methamphetamine, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 20, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when she knowingly and unlawfully possessed with the intent to use, drug paraphernalia for the purpose of planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packing, re-packing, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human body a controlled substance in violation of KRS 218A, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

scientifically reliable test or tests taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability, this being her second such offense within a ten (10) year period, and the Defendant refused to submit to any test or tests of her blood, breath, or urine requested by an officer having reasonable grounds to believe the Defendant was operating or in physical control of a motor vehicle in violation of KRS 189A.010, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about August 30, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Trafficking in a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when she knowingly and unlawfully trafficked in two (2) grams or more of methamphetamine, this being a second or subsequent such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about August 30, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when she knowingly and unlawfully possessed oxycodone, a controlled substance that is classified in Schedule II and is a narcotic drug, this being a third or subsequent such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about August 30, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Trafficking in a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when she knowingly and unlawfully trafficked in a quantity of fentanyl, which is a Schedule I or II narcotic drug, this being her second or subsequent such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about August 30, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Trafficking in a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree when she knowingly and unlawfully trafficked in more than twenty (20) dosage units of gabapentin, clonazepam, and diazepam, each being a controlled substance classified in Schedule IV or V, this being a second or subsequent such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about August 30, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, having been prescribed, sold, or dispensed a controlled substance by a practitioner or other person authorized pursuant to KRS Chapter 218A, unlawfully possessed the controlled substance in a container other than that in which it was delivered to her by the person selling or dispensing same, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:
