The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 8, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully took or exercised control over numerous items of personal property, having a value of less than \$500, same being the moveable property of Walmart, with the intent to deprive the owner thereof, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 8, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly entered or remained unlawfully in a building owned by Walmart, or another entity/person, with the intent to commit a crime, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 8, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Burglary in the Third Degree, in violation of KRS 511.040, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of March 8, 2025, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of March 8, 2025, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of March 8, 2025, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 7, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated or was in physical control of a motor vehicle at such time as the Defendant had

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 4, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant received, retained, or disposed of a 2003 Chevrolet Silverado pickup truck, same being the movable property of [REDACTED], and/or another person, with the intent to deprive the owner, and the defendant knew that the property had been stolen or had reason to believe that it
